THE Bostoner Rebbe, Rav Meir Alter HaLevi Horowitz was a special guest at Beis Yaakov Primary School in Colindale.

After meeting with Head of Kodesh, Mrs Mett, and Head Teacher Mrs Cohen, the Rebbe visited the three classes of the Simmy Richman Nursery, where he was impressed to see the girls acting out the mitzvah of hachnosas orchim.
